#### **TODAY'S GOSPEL: MATTHEW 6:1-21**

"Beware of practicing your piety before men in order to be seen by them; for then you will have no reward from your Father who is in heaven. Thus when you give alms, sound no trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may be praised by men. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you give alms, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your alms may be in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you.

"And when you pray, you must not be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, that they may be seen by men. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you. "And in praying do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do; for they think that they will be heard for their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him. Pray then like this:

Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors; And lead us not into temptation, But deliver us from evil. For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father also will forgive you; but if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

"And when you fast, do not look dismal, like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces that their fasting may be seen by men. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, that your fasting may not be seen by men but your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you. "Do not lay up for your selves treasures on earth, where moth and rust consume and where thieves break in and steal, but lay up for your-selves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust consumes and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also."

Artsakh Newsletter summary prepared by the NKR Office in the United States. The Nagorno Karabakh Republic, Artsakh, was established in 1991 basing on a declaration of the local legislature, and results of a subsequent nation-wide referendum. The people of Artsakh defended their choice in a war unleashed by Azerbaijan. The Nagorno Karabakh Republic, Artsakh has emerged as a democratic, rule-of-law state with capable armed forces, a growing market economy, and an independent foreign policy.

#### **SECURITY & POLITICS**

Foreign Minister Karen Mirzoyan <u>outlined</u> main conditions necessary to resolve the Karabakh conflict in a meeting with faculty and students of Johns Hopkins University's School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS). Visit the website: <u>Artsakh State University</u>.

Foreign Ministers of Armenia and Azerbaijan and OSCE Minsk Group Co-Chars met in Paris to discuss current stage of Karabakh peace process. Stepanakert airport was on the agenda of the meeting. The Government of Azerbaijan adopted a decision apparently designed to justify shooting down of civilian aircraft. Artsakh called on the international community to react to Baku's outrageous threats to target civilian in mid-air. Los Angeles Times published an article by Carol Williams on the continuing international relevance of the Karabakh conflict.

#### **ECONOMY & BUSINESS**

The new Europe Hotel opened its doors in Stepanakert to welcome business travelers and tourists to The Nagorno Karabakh Republic.

HISTORICAL REFERENCE—The pogroms in Baku in January 1990 against its Armenian residents was a culmination of anti-Armenian violence in response to Artsakh's peaceful campaign for reunification with Armenia. Since January 13, 1990, Azerbaijani nationalists launched methodical, house-by-house attacks on Armenians living in the Azerbaijani capital, weeklong attacks that came to be known as Baku pogroms. As a result, scores of Armenians were killed. Soviet authorities evacuated remnants of once 250,000-strong Armenian community of Baku.

#### **BAKU MEMORIAL DEDICATION UPDATE**

We wish to inform our faithful that a new date has been established for the dedication of the Memorial Monument to honor those who perished in the pogroms in Baku, Sumgait and Kirovabad.

Originally, the Baku-Sumgait Monument was to have been completed and installed for a February dedication. However, due to delays in the preparation of the ground and more importantly the delivery and installation of the monument, the date has been deferred to the Spring of 2013. As soon as the committee has the assurance of a guaranteed delivery date for installation, a new dedication date will be announced. Nonetheless, a special *Hokehankisd Service* will be offered on February 24th.

#### SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 24TH HOKEHANKISD

On the occasion of the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Pogroms of the Armenian population in Azerbaijan that began on February 27, 1988 in Sumgait and continued in Baku until 1990, a special Requiem Service / *Bashdon Hokhanksdyan* will be held on Sunday February 24<sup>th</sup>for all our Armenian brothers and sisters who perished.

Rep. Adam Schiff (D-CA) stated in the US Congress from a PR release of ANCA dated February 3, 2011:

" Mr. Speaker, just as we cannot allow the first Genocide of the twentieth century to fade into history, the memory of the victims of Sumgait/ Baku must not be forgotten either."

#### **MONUMENT WORK UPDATE**

The first stage of the installation of the long-awaited new monument adjacent to the Martyrs Monument began with the pouring of the foundation on January 7th. The area is covered while it dries and cures, which is expected to last a few more weeks. We ask our faithful not to walk in the work area until further notice. Thank you for your cooperation.


