THE HOLY CROSS OF VARAK

In 660 A.D. Totig, a solitary Armenian monk by the name of Totig, who lived on Mount Varak had a vision that upon that mountain was a cathedral with twelve pillars in the midst of which was a brilliant a cross. A little later the Cross in the apparition moved slowly down the mountain and rested upon the holy altar of the Monastery of Varak. Totig and his student Hovel rushed to the church and prostrated themselves before a Holy Relic there, which the vision revealed to be truly a piece of the Holy Cross. They believed this was the piece of the Cross which Saint Hripsime had hidden over 300 years ago. They searched and found the piece of Cross intact on the mountain.

St. Hripsime and her companions sought refuge in Armenia as a result of persecution in Rome in the latter part of the third century. They brought with them a relic of the Holy Cross which was given to them by Queen Batronice. While in Armenia Hripsime was persecuted because of her Christian faith and feared that the relic was in danger. She left the relic with pious priests on Mount Varak [near the city of Van in Armenia], and it remained hidden in the secret place where it was buried. Many, like Totig and Hovel, because of their love for the holy relic, passed their lives as monks in seclusion in those mountains, praying for its revelation.

Catholicos Nerses the Builder realized the significance of the event and declared a feast day, still observed today on the second Sunday after the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross. The Feast of *Varaka Khach* is only observed by the Armenian Church.

ARMENIA CELEBRATES 20 YEARS OF INDEPENDENCE

Wednesday, September 21, marked the 20th anniversary of the establishment of the Republic of Armenia. Celebrations in the homeland included services, a parade, and a concert in Yerevan. His Holiness Karekin II, the Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians; His Holiness Aram I, the Catholicos of the Great House of Cilicia; Armenian President Serge Sargsyan; and Nagorno-Karabagh President Bako Sahakyan took part in a blessing service at St. Gregory the Illuminator Cathedral in Yerevan. At the conclusion of events in Armenia, President Sargsyan departed for New York, where he will deliver an address to the United Nations General Assembly on Friday, September 23, and meet with members of the Armenian-American community.
